Our desire is to see healthy, Christ-centered ministries pouring out the love of Christ and meeting the needs of those they are serving, in the most powerful and effective manner. The Church has the opportunity to actively engage with these ministries by calling on the power of the work of the Holy Spirit to accomplish this goal.

But we know that the Holy Spirit knows each situation best.
